Cobaea, commonly known as Cathedral Bells, is a fast-growing vine with stunning purple flowers that bloom in the summer to fall. This low-maintenance plant thrives in full sun to part shade and moderate watering conditions. Its green foliage complements its vibrant blooms, making it a beautiful addition to any garden. Cathedral Bells attract hummingbirds and can be used as a climbing plant or to cover trellises or fences. Pair them with morning glories, sweet peas, or nasturtiums for a visually appealing garden display. Hardy in zones 9-11, *Cobaea* is an excellent choice for adding vertical interest and color to your outdoor space.
