These fast-growing plants thrive in moist, well-drained soil and require high watering. With a low maintenance level, impatiens are perfect for borders, ground covers, or container planting. However, they are susceptible to downy mildew, so proper care is essential. Their unique feature of shade tolerance makes them a valuable addition to any garden, attracting pollinators and adding a burst of color to the landscape. Impatiens pair well with begonias, fuchsias, and coleus as companion plants in the garden.
