Hamamelis virginiana, commonly known as American Witch Hazel, is a deciduous shrub that blooms in the fall with fragrant yellow flowers. This slow to moderate-growing shrub prefers moist, well-draining soil and can thrive in part shade to full sun. Its dark green foliage adds color to the landscape, and its unique fragrance attracts pollinators. American Witch Hazel is low maintenance and generally resistant to pests and diseases. It is an excellent choice for border plantings or woodland gardens and pairs well with Rhododendrons, Azaleas, and Ferns. A versatile and attractive addition to any garden or landscape.
