*Sambucus* Elder Black Tower, also known as Black Tower Elderberry, is a stunning shrub with deep purple foliage and pink flowers that bloom in late spring to early summer. This moderate-growing plant prefers full sun to part shade and well-drained loamy soil. With its compact, columnar shape, it makes an excellent accent plant, hedge, or specimen plant in the garden. Black Tower Elderberry is low-maintenance and resistant to most pests and diseases, making it a popular choice for Canadian landscapes. Pair it with hydrangeas, Japanese maples, or ornamental grasses for a beautiful garden display.
