Hydrangea m ES Bloomstruck, scientifically known as Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bloomstruck', is a stunning shrub with large pink or blue mophead flowers that bloom from summer to fall. Its lush green foliage provides a beautiful backdrop for the vibrant blooms. This hydrangea has a moderate growth rate and requires moderate watering in well-draining soil. It is best planted in part shade to full sun and is suitable for zones 4-9. The Bloomstruck hydrangea is a low-maintenance plant that adds a pop of color to borders or hedges and makes lovely cut flowers. Consider planting it alongside hostas, ferns, or astilbe for a harmonious garden display.
