## Plant Description

Blue Holly (*Ilex meserveae*) is a slow-growing shrub with dark green foliage and white flowers that bloom in spring. The plant produces berries that attract birds and is resistant to deer. It thrives in well-draining, acidic soil and requires moderate watering. Blue Holly is commonly used as a hedge, border plant, or specimen plant in landscaping. It pairs well with companion plants such as Boxwood, Heuchera, and Rhododendron. This attractive shrub adds beauty and interest to any garden while providing food for wildlife.
