This low-maintenance plant thrives in moist, well-drained soil and can tolerate both full sun and part shade. In summer, greenish-brown flowers bloom atop the foliage, attracting pollinators. With its deer-resistant nature and suitability for wet areas, ponds, and borders, *Juncus e spiralis* is a versatile and eye-catching addition to any landscape. Plant it alongside Japanese iris or water lily for a beautiful and harmonious garden display.
