Plant Description

Euonymus compactus, also known as Dwarf Spindle Tree, is a slow-growing shrub with greenish-white flowers that bloom in the spring. Its green foliage and compact size make it an excellent choice for borders or ground cover in shady areas. This plant is drought-tolerant and requires moderate watering. It is relatively low-maintenance and is suitable for hardiness zone 5. Common pests and diseases that may affect *Euonymus compactus* include *Euonymus* scale and crown gall. It can be paired with companion plants like *Hosta* and *Astilbe* to create a beautiful garden landscape.
