Digitalis Foxy, also known as Foxglove, is a stunning biennial plant that produces tall spikes of pink, purple, or white bell-shaped flowers in late spring to early summer. With moderate growth, this plant thrives in part shade to full sun and requires moderate watering. Its green foliage adds a lush backdrop to garden beds, attracting hummingbirds and bees with its sweet nectar. Digitalis Foxy is low-maintenance and perfect for borders, woodland gardens, and cottage gardens, where it can be paired with lilies, columbines, and delphiniums for a beautiful display of color and texture.
