Plant Description

Kohlrabi is a unique vegetable that forms a bulbous stem above the ground, which is harvested for its crunchy texture and mild flavor. This cool-season crop thrives in Canadian climates, especially when planted in well-drained soil and provided with full sun. Kohlrabi can be harvested when the stem reaches 5-10 cm in diameter and can be enjoyed raw in salads or cooked in various dishes. It is relatively low maintenance and can be grown alongside other vegetables like carrots and lettuce as companion plants. Enjoy the fresh taste of homegrown kohlrabi in your garden!
