Leadwort is drought-tolerant and attracts butterflies, making it a lovely addition to any landscaping project. Ideal for ground cover or border planting, *Ceratostigma plumbaginoides* pairs well with companion plants such as Sedum, Salvia, and Coneflowers, creating a visually appealing and sustainable garden display.
