Ilex m Princess, also known as Princess Holly, is a slow-growing evergreen shrub that adds year-round interest to your garden. This beautiful shrub produces white flowers in spring, followed by red berries in winter, attracting birds to your yard. With its glossy green foliage and compact growth habit, Princess Holly is perfect for hedges or as a specimen plant. It thrives in well-drained, acidic soil and requires moderate watering. Hardy in zones 4-7, this low-maintenance shrub is a great addition to any landscape, especially when paired with companion plants like Rhododendron and Azalea.
