Plant Description

Cornus kousa Satomi, commonly known as Satomi Dogwood, is a beautiful tree with pink flowers that bloom in late spring to early summer. This moderate grower has green foliage and a rounded shape, reaching 6-8 meters in height and spread. It thrives in part shade with moderate watering and prefers well-drained, loamy soil. Dogwood Anthracnose and Powdery Mildew are common pests and diseases to watch out for. With its attractive fall colors and ability to attract birds, *Cornus kousa* Satomi is a wonderful addition to any landscape as an ornamental or specimen tree. Consider planting it alongside Rhododendrons or Hydrangeas for a stunning garden display.
