## Plant Description

*Viburnum opulus* 'Roseum', commonly known as Snowball Bush, is a moderate-growing shrub with large, round clusters of white flowers in late spring to early summer. Its green foliage provides a beautiful backdrop to the showy blooms and turns a deep red in the fall. This low-maintenance shrub thrives in full sun to part shade and is suitable for border plantings or as a specimen plant in gardens. Snowball Bush is drought-tolerant once established and attracts butterflies to the garden with its fragrant flowers. It is a versatile plant that pairs well with lilac, hydrangea, and weigela in landscaping.
