## Plant Description

*Gleditsia tri* Sunburst, also known as Sunburst Honeylocust, is a fast-growing tree with stunning bright yellow foliage in spring and golden yellow leaves in fall. This low-maintenance tree is perfect for providing shade in gardens or landscapes and is tolerant of drought and pollution. Its thornless nature makes it safe for planting near walkways or play areas. The Sunburst Honeylocust adds a pop of color to any garden and attracts pollinators with its greenish-yellow flowers in the spring. Plant alongside Red Maple or Eastern Redbud for a beautiful garden display.
