## Plant Description

*Dictamnus albus Albiflorus*, commonly known as White Dittany, is a slow-growing perennial with white flowers that bloom in the summer. This plant thrives in full sun and well-drained sandy soil, making it ideal for borders or rock gardens. White Dittany is drought-tolerant and requires low maintenance, but it may be susceptible to powdery mildew. Pairing it with lavender or catmint can create a beautiful and fragrant garden display. In Canadian hardiness zones 4-7, *Dictamnus albus Albiflorus* adds a touch of elegance with its delicate white flowers and green foliage.
