Digitalis Dalmatian White, also known as *White Foxglove*, is a stunning perennial with white bell-shaped flowers that bloom in the summer. This plant thrives in partially shaded areas with moist, well-drained soil. With its moderate growth rate and low maintenance requirements, it is a perfect addition to borders, woodland gardens, or cottage gardens. *Digitalis Dalmatian White* is also known for attracting pollinators and being resistant to deer. Pairing it with companion plants like *Echinacea*, *Salvia*, or *Nepeta* can create a beautiful and vibrant garden display in Canadian weather conditions.
